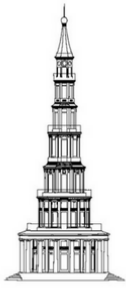

Duration : minimum 1h

Discovery of the Enlightenment with the historical figure of the Duke of Choiseul, minister of King Louis XV and governor of Touraine in the 18th century.

The splendor of the Palais Disparu - Virtual reconstitution of the Chanteloup castle and gardens at their peak.

Visit of the Pagoda - Historical monument built by the Duke of Choiseul with panoramic views over the Loire Valley and the Amboise forest at 44m height.

The garden of Fû Hsi - Come to discover the small Chinese garden, its oriental essences and its Chinoiseries.

An "old-fashioned" wooden play area enlivens your walk, for adults and children.

Boat trips on the water mirror (5 € / h).

Picnic areas - Gift shop – Salon de Thé
